Warranty

Products Manufactured by Advancelab: Advancelab(S) Pte.Ltd., warrants products that it manufactures to be free from defects for a period of 12 months for parts, commencing from the date of shipment. Advancelab's sole responsibility is to repair or replace, at its option, any part of the product that proves defective or malfunctioning during this time limit. This warranty is void if the equipment is abused or modified by the customer, is operated outside Advancelab's operating instructions or specifications, or is used in any application other than that for which it is specified. This warranty does not include routine maintenance or service procedures, breakage, shipping damage, nor damage from misuse, intentional or unintentional abuse, neglect, natural disasters, or acts of God.

Freight Shortage or Damage: Upon receipt of any equipment from Advancelab, customer shall immediately unpack and inspect for damage or shortage. The customer shall not accept a damaged package or a short shipment until the carrier makes a "damage or shortage" notation on both the carrier's and customer's copy of the freight bill or delivery receipt. Service title passes when the shipment is loaded, so customer is responsible for filing and collecting a freight claim. Any replacement products must be ordered and paid for separately.

Generally, customers can improve the chance of collecting on a freight claim by following these procedures:

- 1. Formally requesting that the carrier inspect the shipment immediately upon suspecting damage or shortage to verify condition.
- 2. Notifying the carrier upon discovery of concealed damage and requesting an inspection within 15 days of receipt, both in person or phone and following up via mail.
- 3. Keeping the shipment as intact as possible, including retaining original packaging materials and keeping the product as close to the original receiving location as possible.
- 4. Holding salvage for disposition by the carrier.

All Claims: Advancelab (S) Pte.Ltd., expressly disclaims all other warranties, expressed or implied or implied by statute, including the warranties of merchantability or fitness for intended use. Advancelab is not responsible for consequential or incidental damages arising out of the purchase or use of the products supplied by Advancelab. 


Minilab® Wet Scrubber

- 3. Chemical Pump









Installation

Procedure

- Prior to installation, check mist eliminators for shifting or damage.
- Inspect all piping for breakages.
- The scrubber Tellerette packing, scrubber body, mist eliminator, and transitions should be thoroughly cleaned with a hose spray nozzle to wash any foreign material out of scrubber sump prior to connecting drain piping. Debris can cause pump malfunction.
- Connect the duct from the lab to the "Exhaust Inlet"
- Connect the duct from the exhaust fan to the "Exhaust Outlet"
- Connect the incoming water supply
- Connect the over-flow drain
- Connect the power plug
- Operating conditions: Should not be used on temperatures exceeding 80degC and exposed to direct sunlight.

2. Pre-start-up Checklist

- Fan and pump motor wired for correct voltage.
- All dampers locked in open position.
- Ductwork clean and free of debris.
- Ductwork sealed properly.
- Plumbing connections leak tested.
- Freshwater make-up set correctly.
- Overflow and drain connected.
- Packing and mist eliminator installed properly.
- Correct spray pattern.

3. Start-up

- Switch on water supply.
- Switch on pump.
- Switch on exhaust fan.

Scheduled Maintenance

Proper and timely maintenance is crucial for trouble free functioning of any device and your Advancelab Wet Scrubber is no exception to this rule. We strongly recommend that you follow the maintenance schedule suggested hereunder in order to obtain performance from your Advancelab Wet Scrubber.

Trouble Shooting

Problem	Possible cause
Poor spray pattern	 Spray nozzles plugged up Spray headers plugged up Pump suction blocked Pump discharge piping too small Insufficient water in sump Pump running backwards Total head exceeds that of pump
Unit will not drain	 Drain line to remote tank is not submerged or trapped Drain line is not sloped towards tank Drain line plugged Drain line too small
